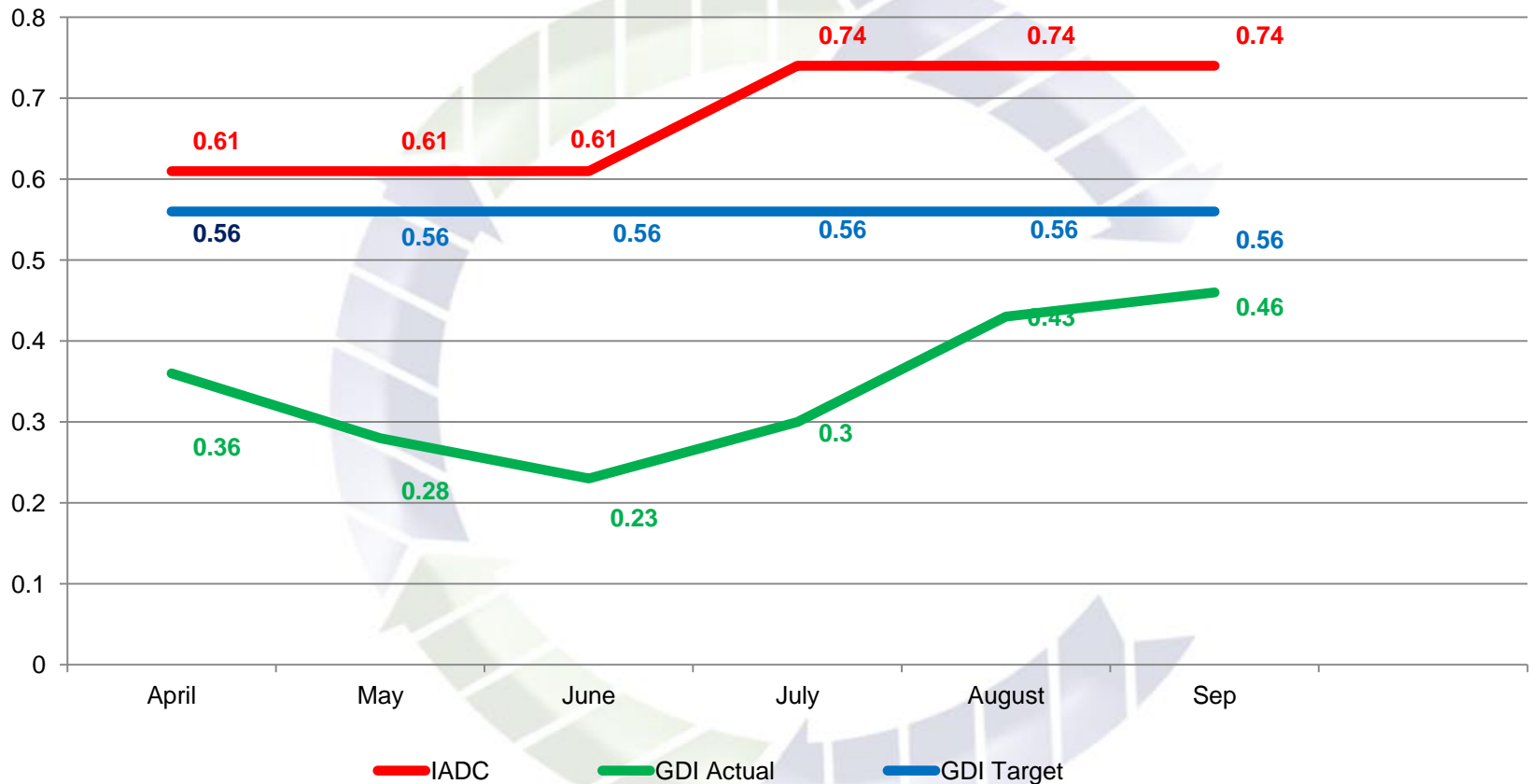

# TRIR Benchmarking Apr-11 to Sep-11

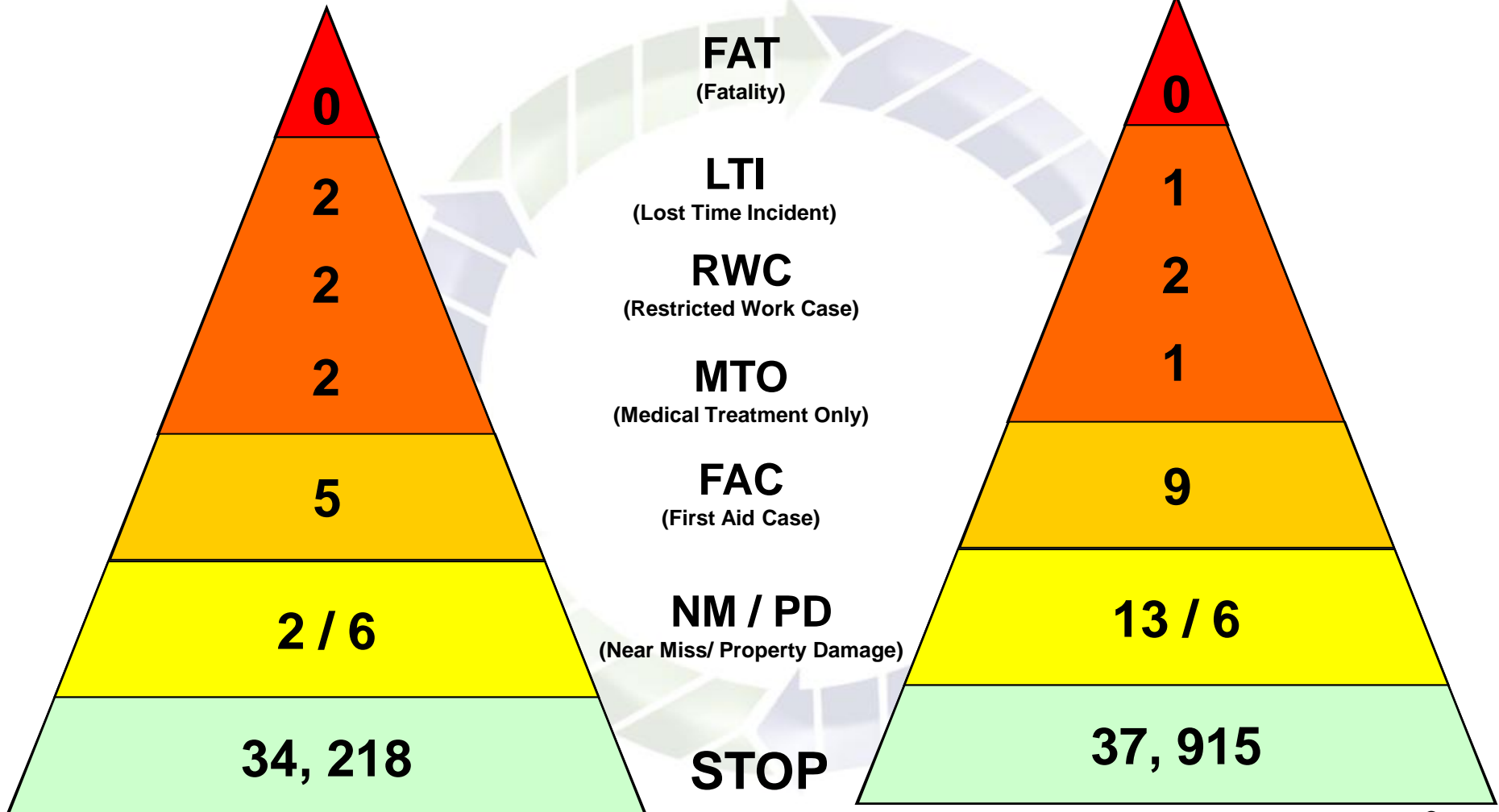
## GDI Target Vs GDI Actual Vs IADC ME Average



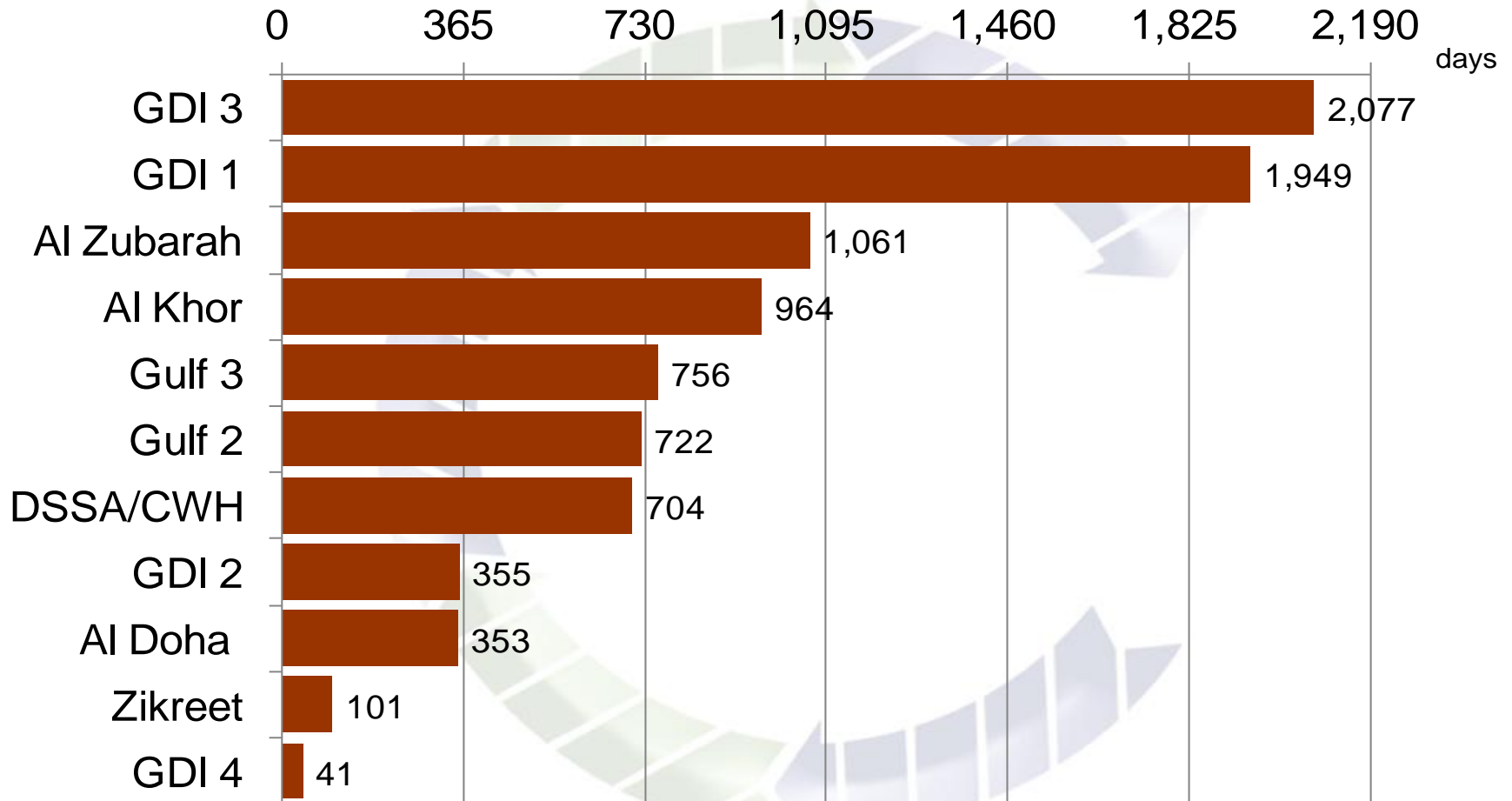
# HSE Statistics Comparison

## SAFETY LESSON

The safety lesson is a GDI initiative that was introduced during Q1 of 2011 and since its inception, about 38 editions have been issued.

It is a proactive program aimed at improving crew safety awareness in enhancing incident prevention by taking info from STOP reports, inspections / audit findings, etc & cascading lessons learnt across board.

## SAFETY LESSON-19

**Date:** 21-Jul-11

### What Happened:

During an HSE Inspection tour on one of our rigs, an unsafe practice was observed with regards to Lock out/ Tag Out procedure as shown in picture 1 below.

Subsections 4.0 and 5.1 of the GDI HSEMS.01/03 "Lock Out / Tag Out Procedure" clearly outlined the definitions and steps to carry out a Lock out / Tag out operation in GDI.



**Pic 1:** shows unsafe practice by using safety pin to effect mechanical lock out on a valve and the tag was not filled out as required.



**Pic 2:** shows the safe practice to carry out Lock / Tag out in line with GDI procedure HSEMS.01/03.

### Action Taken:

The observation was discussed with concerned party and further highlighted during rig supervisors daily operations meetings and crew HSE meetings with emphasis on strict adherence to HSEMS procedures in enhancing safe, effective and incident free operations.

By issuing this safety lesson, QHSE wish to encourage all supervisors to kindly review the observations with their esteemed crew members with emphasis on the need to carry out every task with safety practice and right attitude in order to prevent potential incidents.

## The Push / Pull Pole

The Push / Pull Pole is a tool that was designed to enhance “Hands-Free”

Lifting practice.

It was introduced to GDI by one of our client and after successful trials , they proved very effective and fit for purpose.

They have now been purchased and supplied for all our rigs as part of the GDI awareness campaign on “Hands and Finger Injury” prevention.



## The KONG Gloves

The KONG Gloves offer additional protection to users in terms of impact resistance and severity of injury.

As part of the GDI awareness campaign on “Hands and Finger Injury” prevention, the KONG Gloves has now introduced and included in the approved PPEs for required rig crews because of the additional protection it offers.
