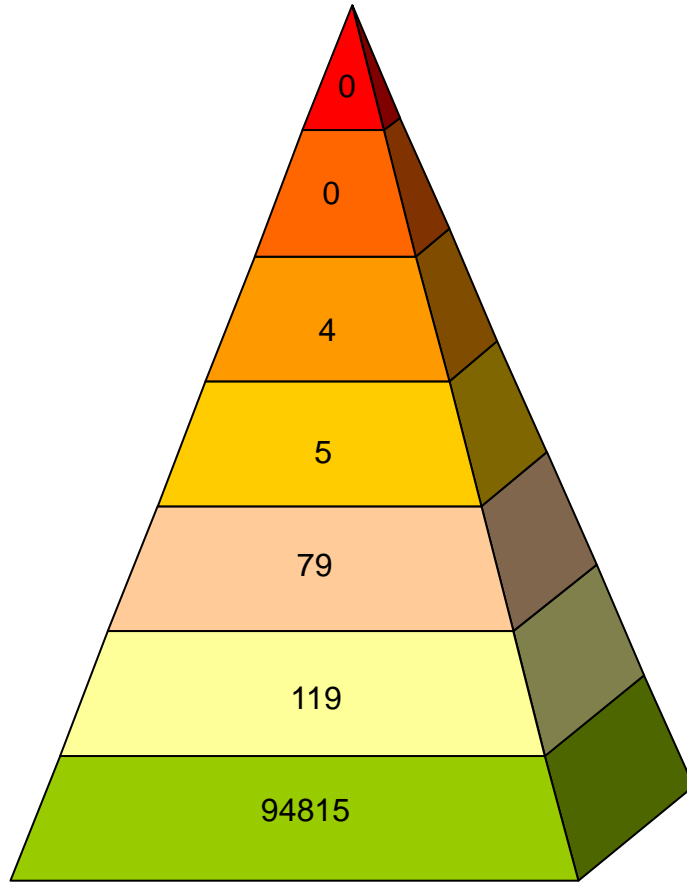

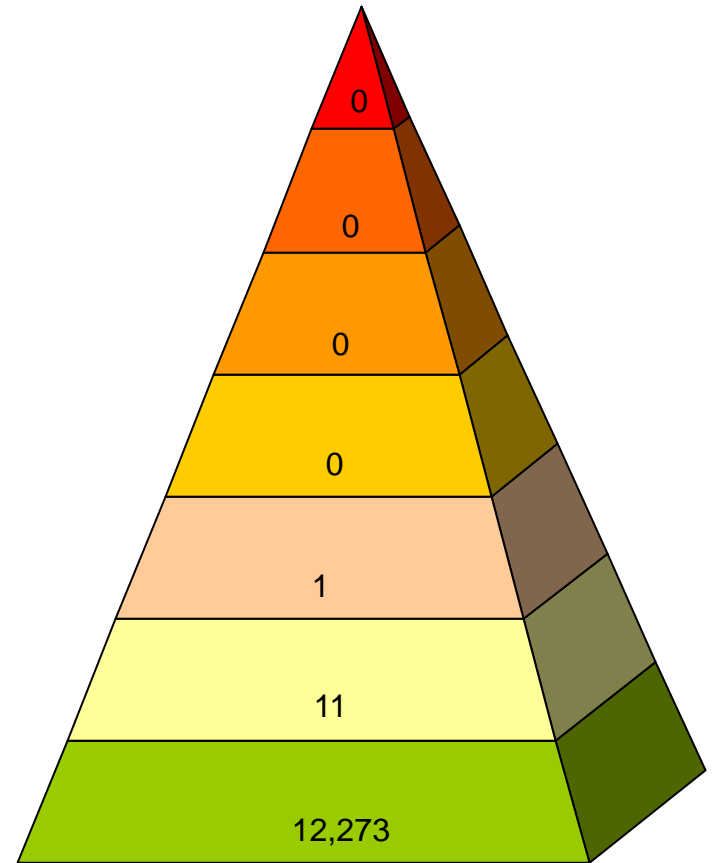

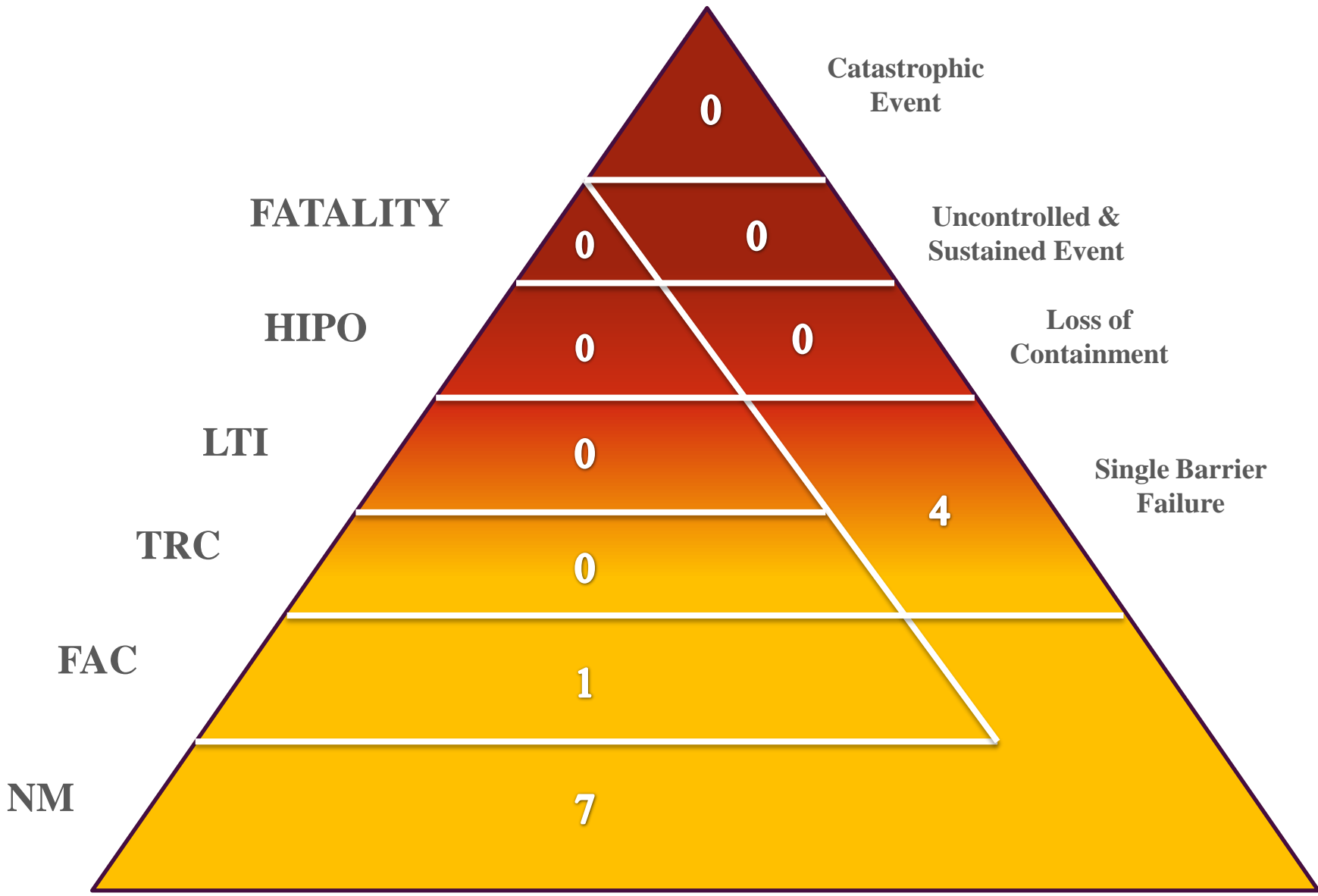

Near Misses since last DOIRC

- **2 June 2011 – Overloaded Bottle Rack – Outside of Certification**
- **15 June 2011 – Rig Emergency Generator did not start**
- **11 Aug 2011 – Upper Sheave Wheel Bushings fell to rig floor**
- **29 Aug 2011 – SBF - BOP failed pressure test – lower blind RAM/shear door bonnet seal leaked**
- **9 Oct 2011 – SBF – Kill master Valve on choke manifold leaked during BOP pressure test**
- **31 Oct 2011 – SBF – Upper Pipe Rams leaked during BOP test**
